#### **AMENDMENTS TO AGENDA**

Vice-Mayor Cheatham made a motion to amend the agenda to add a topic on behalf of Southampton Memorial Hospital to add a presentation asking for the City's support and assistance. Councilman Burgess seconded the motion.

The motion was approved by a 6 – 0 vote (Councilman Johnson absent).

Mayor Rabil added the discussion to the Old/New Business section of the agenda and assigned it as item A moving everything in the section down one letter.

#### **Consent Agenda**

##### **Minutes of the October 22, 2018 Regular Meeting**

Mayor Rabil asked if there were any corrections or changes to the October 22, 2018 Regular meeting minutes. There were several typographical errors that were addressed and with those corrections, Councilman Burgess made a motion to approve the minutes with the necessary changes and Vice-Mayor Cheatham seconded the motion.

Hearing no other questions or comments, Mayor Rabil called for the question and Council voted.

The motion was approved by a 6 – 0 vote (Councilman Johnson absent).

### **Minutes of the October 24, 2018 Called Meeting**

Mayor Rabil asked if there were any corrections or changes to the October 24, 2018 Called meeting minutes. Mayor Rabil asked if there were any questions or comments concerning the October 24<sup>th</sup> Called meeting. There were no questions or comments.

Vice-Mayor Cheatham made the motion to approve the minutes as presented and Councilwoman Copeland seconded the motion.

Hearing no other questions or comments, Mayor Rabil called for the question and Council voted.

The motion was approved by a 6 – 0 vote (Councilman Johnson absent).

Councilman Johnson arrived late to the meeting at 7:05 p.m.

### **Minutes of the November 7, 2018 Called Meeting**

Mayor Rabil asked if there were any corrections or changes to the November 7, 2018 Called meeting minutes. Councilman McLemore was noted absent in the attendance but he did attend the meeting. With that change addressed and corrected, Councilwoman Copeland made a motion to approve the minutes with the necessary changes and Councilman Burgess seconded the motion.

Hearing no other questions or comments, Mayor Rabil called for the question and Council voted

The motion was approved by a 7 – 0 vote.

### **Public Hearing**

There was a Public Hearing to hear comments from the public on the SPSA resolution to adopted Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation and a Concurrent Resolution to adopt Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation for SPSA.

Interim City Manager Monday recognized City Attorney Taylor Williams who shared the purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive public comment on the proposed Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation regarding term limitations for members of SPSA's Board of Directors before considering adoption of the Amendment to the Articles.

### **The Public Hearing was opened at 7:11 p.m.**

Mayor Rabil opened the floor for the Public Hearing to hear citizen comments at 7:11 p.m. Mayor Rabil asked if anyone would like to speak 3 times and there was no response. There were no citizens' that spoke.

### **The Public Hearing was closed at 7:12 p.m.**

Mayor Rabil asked if there were any questions or comments. After some discussion among Council members, the matter was voted on. Mayor Rabil stated that the actions would be addressed separately.

Councilman Burgess made a motion to approve the Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation of the Southeastern Public Service Authority of Virginia and Councilman Johnson seconded it.

The motion was approved by a 7 – 0 vote.

Mayor Rabil asked if there were any questions or comments. Hearing no further comments or questions, Council members voted.

Vice-Mayor Cheatham made the motion to approve the Concurrent Resolution Adopting the Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation for the Southeastern Public Service Authority of Virginia and Councilman Johnson seconded the motion.

The motion was approved by a 7 – 0 vote.

## **FINANCE**

### **FY 2017-2018 Audit Presentation Report**

Interim City Manager Monday recognized Interim Director Tracy Gregory who recognized the members of the Finance staff and thanked them and all departments associated with the audit for all their hard work in preparation of and during the audit. The members of the Finance staff in attendance were: Ms. Melisa Blythe, Ms. Nancy Layman, Ms. Joyce Johnson, Ms. Sandy Turner, Ms. Sandy Smith and Ms. Joe Ann Faulk. Interim Director Gregory introduced Ms. Robin Jones of Creedle, Jones & Alga, CPA's.

Ms. Jones distributed the summary report of the FY 2017 – 2018 Comprehensive Audit Financial Report (CAFR). Copies of the entire CAFR were distributed previously to Council. Ms. Jones reported to Council that the audit results were characterized as a clean opinion, also known as an unmodified opinion. Ms. Jones also stated that there were an additional 60 pages added in this year's audit related to new audit requirements.

Ms. Jones gave an overview on the report, as well as, detailed the responsibilities of both Management and the auditors. Ms. Jones reported to Council that they did find a few notable findings in the FY 2017 – 2018 audit concerning processes in reconciliation with the Franklin City Public Schools. She commented that these issues were addressed with FCPS toward the end of the audit. Ms. Jones asked if there were any questions from Council and after discussing them she noted if anyone had any questions in the future her contact information was listed on the documentation that she distributed. Mayor Rabil thanked Ms. Jones for all the hard work and stated that if Council had any questions concerning the report they reserved the right to contact her regarding them.

Interim City Manager Monday commended the staff and the Ms. Robin Jones of Creedle, Jones & Alga, CPA's for all their hard work and getting the report to Council in a very timely manner; as well as, Interim Director Tracy Gregory, Finance staff, all the departments and outside agencies involved in the completion of the audit process.

**OLD/NEW BUSINESS**

**Southampton Memorial Hospital Presentation**

Mayor Rabil recognized Attorney Williams to present the Southampton Memorial Hospital (SMH) Presentation and to introduce Mrs. Kim Marks and Mr. Scott Johnson of Hancock Daniel.

Mrs. Marks stated that the hospital is asking the City to support an opportunity to get additional Medicaid compensation from a federal program dependent upon new legislation that will be considered by the State General Assembly in the next legislative session. If the legislation is passed by the General Assembly, the City will provide assistance by acting as the recipient of the additional compensation on behalf of SMH. The City will receive this compensation on a quarterly basis and pass the additional compensation on to SMH. It will not result in the need of additional employees to receive these funds on behalf of SMH.

Mr. Johnson presented a PowerPoint and asked the Council to adopt a resolution in support of a health care provider assessment to be paid by SMH to support Medicaid patients in the Franklin community. Mr. Johnson explained the process and which is as follows:

SMH requests the City to pass an ordinance
City passes an ordinance to collect health care provider assessment
SMH wires assessment to city quarterly
Assessment amount based on formula of SMH Medicaid services
City wires assessment to Dept. of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS) quarterly
DMAS obtains federal match
DMAS pays SMH quarterly supplemental Medicaid payment

Mr. Johnson assured the City Council that this request does not do any of the following:

- ❖ Does not request any City \$
- ❖ Does not request any State \$
- ❖ Does not require City to hire anyone because there are only four wire transfer receipts and four wire transfers out per year
- ❖ Does not financially obligate or encumber the City

After some discussion among the City Council, Mrs. Marks and Mr. Johnson, Mayor Rabil asked for the desired action of Council. Mayor Rabil asked Vice-Mayor Cheatham read the resolution aloud.

Vice-Mayor Cheatham made the motion to adopt a resolution in support of a health care provider assessment to be paid by SMH to support Medicaid patients in the Franklin community

The motion was approved by 7 – 0 vote.

**Resolution to Adopt USDA Forms for Police Vehicle Grant**

Interim City Manager Monday introduced a Resolution to adopt USDA Forms for Police Vehicle Grant. Interim City Manager Monday explained to Council that this grant issued from USDA, otherwise known as the Rural Development Program utilizes grant funds to offset the cost of purchasing police vehicles. He stated there is a resolution required by Council. In order to become eligible for this grant the city will

have to follow the required regulations in which Council will have to ask the Federal Government for a match or you will not get the funds. He stated that staff recommends this approval of Resolution #2018-06.

After a considerable discussion among the member of Council, Mayor Rabil asked for the desired action of Council.

Vice-Mayor Cheatham motioned to accept Resolution #2018-06 to adopt USDA Forms for Police Vehicle Grant and it was seconded by Wynndolyn Copeland, Councilwoman.

The motion was approved with a 7 – 0 vote.

Councilman Burgess rendered another motion of City Manager Monday to produce the service records of the fleet vehicles and to reexamine the fleet policy within the next two months.

The motion was seconded by Vice-Mayor Cheatham.

The motion was approved with a 7 – 0 vote.

#### **Agreement with Cypress Cove Country Club**

City Manager introduced the Agreement with the Cypress Cove Country Club. This matter was on the Agenda for discussion as well as Southampton County's Agenda.

Councilman McLemore made a motion to scrap the agreement completely and Councilman Cutchins seconded it.

The motion failed to pass due to a lack of majority. The vote was as follows:

Councilman Johnson, NAY; Councilman Cutchins, AYE; Councilwoman Copeland, AYE; Vice-Mayor Cheatham, NAY; Mayor Rabil, ABSTAIN; Councilman McLemore, AYE; and Councilman Burgess, NAY.

This matter was deferred for discussion at a later time.

#### **Ordinance Amendment Authorizing Increase of School Board Salaries**

Mayor Rabil recognized City Attorney Williams to present the Ordinance Amendment Authorizing the Increase of the School Board salaries.

Attorney Williams reminded Council that at the meeting on October 22, 2018, Council considered the issue of allowing the School Board to provide for salary increases for the Chairman and the members of the School Board. On October 22<sup>nd</sup>, Council adopted a motion to allow the School Board to increase the salaries. Now Council is asked to amend City Code Section 2-73 to raise the potential salaries of the members of the School Board and the Chairman to the amount allowed in the City Charter. Attached you will find a proposed motion to amend the existing ordinance 2-73 was recommended by staff.

Mayor Rabil asked Council for questions or comments on the matter. After Council remarks, Mayor Rabil asked for a motion.



Councilman Burgess read the resolution aloud while making the motion to adopt the Ordinance Amendment authorizing the increase of School Board and Chairman Salaries and Councilman Johnson seconded it.

The motion was approved with the vote as follows:

Councilman Johnson, AYE; Councilman Cutchins, AYE; Councilwoman Copeland, AYE; Vice-Mayor Cheatham, AYE; Mayor Rabil, AYE; Councilman McLemore, ABSTAIN; and Councilman Burgess, AYE.

### **DFA Presentation Regarding Possible Amendment of Agreement**

The current Letter of Agreement (LOA) between the City and Downtown Franklin Association (DFA) has been in effect since 2002. Dan Howe, Executive Director of DFA, discussed the following with the Council:

- 1) Need to amend the current LOA.
- 2) Present a draft LOA for consideration.
- 3) Seek input from the Council for adoption in the revised LOA.
- 4) Discuss next steps

Mr. Howe distributed some information concerning the Letter of Agreement and his presentation. A revised LOA will be brought back to the Council for approval, following Council's input.

During the discussion among Council and staff it was the consensus to schedule a work session at a future date.

### **City Manager's Report**

#### **Edmunds Software Update**

Mayor Rabil recognized Interim City Manager Monday to present the Edmunds Software Update. Interim City Manager Monday reported that since the last Council meeting, city staff had met numerous times to assess the effectiveness of the system components installed to this point and to determine what outstanding modules are not provided as specified in the the RFP. Edmunds staff came to Franklin on November 14<sup>th</sup> and met face-to-face with the City's Project Management Team.

The focus of the meetings was on the Tax Module and other outstanding items. Edmunds staff interacted with the City Team and expressed no reservations about delivering a completed product. Interim City Manager Monday recognized Steve Newsome, City IT Director and Project Manager, to provide a more detailed summary of the meeting including a projected timeline.

Director Newsome reported on the progress of the work with the software and the proposed timeline for completion and implementation. Director Newsome also discussed the need of a decision from Council in the near future regarding the online pay component, specifically, transaction fees.

After much discussion among staff and Council members, it was the consensus of Council to discuss this issue at a further date, possibly in a work session after staff has time to prepare a thorough presentation concerning the matter.

**Open Positions Update**

Interim City Manager Monday gave an update on the status of his vacant position work plan. The information he shared was as follows:

Interim City Manager Monday stated that the Police Chief interviews were scheduled for Wednesday, December 5, 2018 and asked that Council appoint a member to be present during the process.

Councilman Burgess made a motion to appoint Mayor Rabil and Councilman McLemore to be the Council Representatives to observe the interview process for the Police Chief position and Councilwoman Copeland seconded it.

The motion was approved by a 7 – 0 vote.

**Disposal of Public Property**

Interim City Manager Monday reminded Council of their consideration of a request at the October 22<sup>nd</sup> Council meeting from Police Chief Philip Hardison to purchase his department issued computer upon his retirement. In order to ensure elimination of sensitive data, Council directed staff to bring the matter back at its next meeting.

In short, the memo states that if the Council approves the Chief’s request, there must be no potential for system access internally, and actions can be taken to “clean” or remove information from the device.

The City’s IT Director (Newsome) has discussed the above referenced memo with Deputy Chief Porti and concurs that appropriate steps can be taken to factory reset the device, thus remove content.

After considerable discussion among Council on the matter, Mayor Rabil asked what was the desired action of Council.

Councilman Johnson made the motion to allow Chief Hardison to purchase the computer for \$450.53 after the device had been through the factory reset and Councilwoman Copeland seconded it.

The motion was approved with the vote as follows:

Councilman Johnson, AYE; Councilman Cutchins, AYE; Councilwoman Copeland, AYE; Vice-Mayor Cheatham, AYE; Mayor Rabil, AYE; Councilman McLemore, NAY; and Councilman Burgess, AYE.

**COUNCIL/STAFF REPORTS ON BOARDS/COMMISSIONS**

Vice-Mayor Cheatham deferred to Interim City Manager Monday to report on the HRTPO meeting. Vice-Mayor Cheatham reported on the HRPDC meeting, where they were given an update on offshore wind turbines. The annual audit for the HRPDC yielded a clean opinion. Vice-Mayor Cheatham reported on WTRJ meeting, as well. Currently the jail is operating without a Finance Director, so they have brought in someone to help prepare for the audit.

Councilman Johnson applauded the local bands for their performance in the Grand Illumination parade in Norfolk on November 17, 2018. He stated that the parade would be on television sometime in the next week.

Vice-Mayor Cheatham reported on two surprise audits at the jail recently and they went very well. The jail is doing great and the leadership at the jail is doing a good job.

Interim City Manager Monday stated that the HRTPO and HRTAC will be holding a joint meeting in December. Nothing else to report.

Councilman Burgess deferred to Interim City Manager Monday to report on the Business Center Advisory Board meeting.

Councilman Johnson reported on the Southeastern Virginia Food Bank and a tour that he had taken them on here in the City of Franklin. He spoke of concerns about hunger within our community and ways to help diminish the problem.

Councilman Burgess stated that he did not report on the Business Center Advisory Board because he is on the Board of the Franklin Experience. He stated that the members of the Business Center Advisory Board are a group of hard working individuals and they are always fair. They collaborate together well and are very helpful in building our community.

Mayor Rabil reminded Council of the Christmas parade on Friday, December 7<sup>th</sup>. He also reminded them of the Employee Christmas Luncheon on Friday, December 14<sup>th</sup>. Mayor Rabil commented on the success of the Shop Small Saturday.

**Closed Session**

Councilwoman Copeland made a motion that the Franklin City Council to discuss prospective candidates for employment and to meet in consultation with legal counsel pertaining to a legal matter requiring legal advice and pertaining to possible litigation pursuant to Virginia Code Section 2.2-3711 (A) (1) and (A) (7) & (8). Vice-Mayor Cheatham seconded the motion.

The motion was approved by a vote of 7 – 0.

**The Council entered into closed session at 9:30 p.m.**

Mayor Rabil reconvened the open session at 10:29 p.m. and asked for a motion certifying the closed session.

Councilwoman Copeland made a motion certifying that the only matters discussed during the closed session were those lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements and identified in the motion by which the closed session was convened. The motion was seconded by Vice-Mayor Cheatham.

The motion was approved by a 7 – 0 vote.

Vice-Mayor Cheatham made a motion to adjourn the meeting which was seconded by Councilman Johnson.

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The offshore wind energy market is emerging in North America. With a potential build-out of at least 20,000 megawatts (MW) of installed capacity (or 2,000 - 3,000 wind turbines) along the East Coast over the next two decades, Virginia is well positioned as a prime location for the offshore wind supply chain and service industry. As the demand for wind energy increases, experts predict that over 14,000 jobs will be created in the construction, maintenance, manufacturing and other service-related industries.

Recent briefings to the HRPDC from Virginia's Department of Mines, Minerals and Energy (DMME) and Old Dominion University's Center for Physical Coastal Oceanography have identified a number of benefits for the Hampton Roads region from the development of offshore wind along the mid-Atlantic coast:

- competitive market advantages in Hampton Roads for attracting the offshore wind industry
- energy and environmental benefits with the development of renewable energy sources
- advancement of the region's goals to diversify the economy and increase higher-paying jobs.

A demonstration project for offshore wind is currently under development off the coast of Virginia. Dominion Energy contracted in 2017 with Ørsted Energy of Denmark to build Coastal Virginia Offshore Wind (CVOW), a two turbine, 12 megawatt (MW) demonstration project located 23.5 nautical miles off the Virginia Beach coastline. The CVOW project is scheduled for completion in 2020 and will lay the groundwork for potential large-scale commercial development up to 2,000 MW.

Enclosed is a copy of the HRPDC resolution supporting offshore wind development. Also enclosed is a draft resolution of Council support should you wish to consider.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION: For the Council's consideration. If the Council opts to support offshore wind development, a motion is required to adopt the enclosed resolution.**

**Resolution of the Hampton Roads Planning District Commission supporting  
offshore wind development off the coast of Virginia**

**Whereas**, recent reports by the Virginia Department of Mines, Minerals and Energy have identified the potential for significant economic development opportunities for the Commonwealth of Virginia and the Hampton Roads region from the emerging offshore wind industry; and

**Whereas**, the U. S. East Coast opportunity for offshore wind extends from South Carolina to New England and has a twenty-year buildout potential of 20,000 megawatts of installed capacity (2,000 – 3,000 wind turbines) with the potential to generate over 14,000 jobs in the construction, maintenance, manufacturing and other service related industries; and

**Whereas**, Dominion Energy contracted in 2017 with a global wind leader, Ørsted Energy of Denmark, to build Coastal Virginia Offshore (CVOW), a two turbine, 12 MW demonstration project located 23.5 nautical miles offshore from the Virginia Beach coastline. The CVOW project is targeted for completion in 2020 and will lay the groundwork for potential large-scale commercial development up to 2,000 MW; and

**Whereas**, studies of the market opportunities for attracting the offshore wind industry to the U. S. East Coast have identified several unique competitive advantages for Virginia and the Hampton Roads region, including:

- Pro-Business Climate
- America's Largest Shipbuilding Industry
- Unmatched Port Infrastructure
- Congestion-Free Harbor Navigation
- Progressive State Energy Policy
- Zero Air Draft for Ocean-Going Vessels
- High-Quality Workforce



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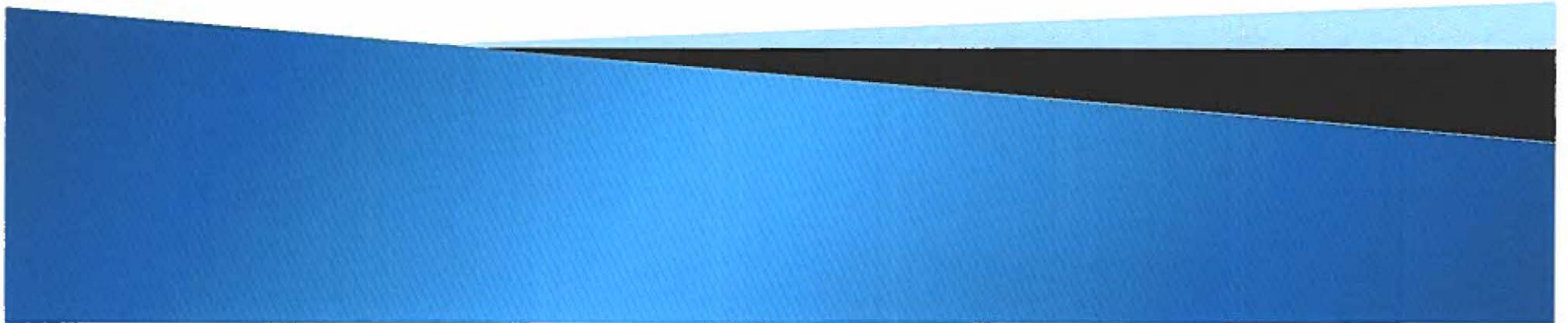

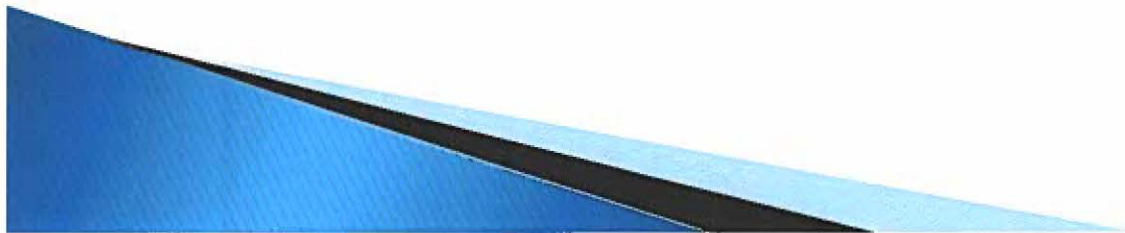

# City Treasurer 2018 Annual Report

Delinquent Taxes as of  
November 30, 2018



The delinquent tax amount for the City of Franklin as of November 30, 2018 is \$334,163.82. This amount reflects tax years 2016 and older for all taxes owed to the city. The last collection report dated November 30, 2017 was reported with delinquencies of \$295,453.71



# Real Estate

As of November 30, 2018 there is \$175,420.41 in delinquent Real Estate taxes for years 2001–2016. We currently have 20 taxpayers of monthly payment plans or have attached wage liens against their employment. The Treasurer's office continues to work with Jason A Dunn, PLC (Tax Attorney) out of VA Beach to assist in selling properties who meet the requirement for a tax sale based on Code of Virginia 58.1–3965.1 . There are currently 26 properties being worked by Mr. Dunn's Firm.



# Real Estate Cont...

Mr. Dunn's Firm will also work with property owners who are willing to enter into a payment agreement to keep property from being sold at a Tax Sale.

For RE2017 tax year, of the 5.5 Million budgeted, we have \$186,748.51 uncollected, showing a 97% collection rate as of November 30, 2018.





# Personal Property

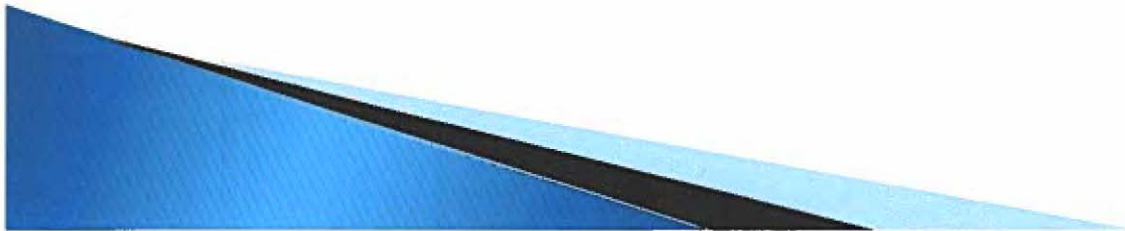
As of November 30, 2018 there is \$148,975.74 in delinquent personal property taxes for tax years 2008–2016. We continue to work with taxpayers on monthly payment plans. These plans are broken down to payments that will have the account paid off before the next billing cycle. If taxpayers pay their payment plan as agreed, they will have no additional collection action taken against them. If plans are broken without some form of communication, collection allowed by the state code will commence.



# Personal Property Cont....

For PP2017 tax year, of the 2.8 million budgeted, we have \$76,842.04 uncollected, showing a 97% collection rate as of November 30, 2018.

Due to the Statute of Limitations as per Code of Virginia 58.1-3040, I will be requesting Council to approve charging off Personal Property 2012 in the amount of \$20,185.50. Based on years of collection attempts, I deem these accounts uncollectable.



# Business License

As of November 30, 2018 there is one delinquent business license in the amount of \$13.52 for tax year 2014. This business is no longer in operation and the owner has not been located.



# Meals and Lodging

Currently there is \$9,754.15 in delinquent meals tax and \$00.00 lodging. One delinquent business is currently on a payment plan with the office and continues to pay weekly payments. The requirement for being on a plan is to file and pay all current Meals Tax when due. The other business has closed and the owner is deceased. The filing of these taxes were filed after the closing of the business making it impossible to collect at that time.

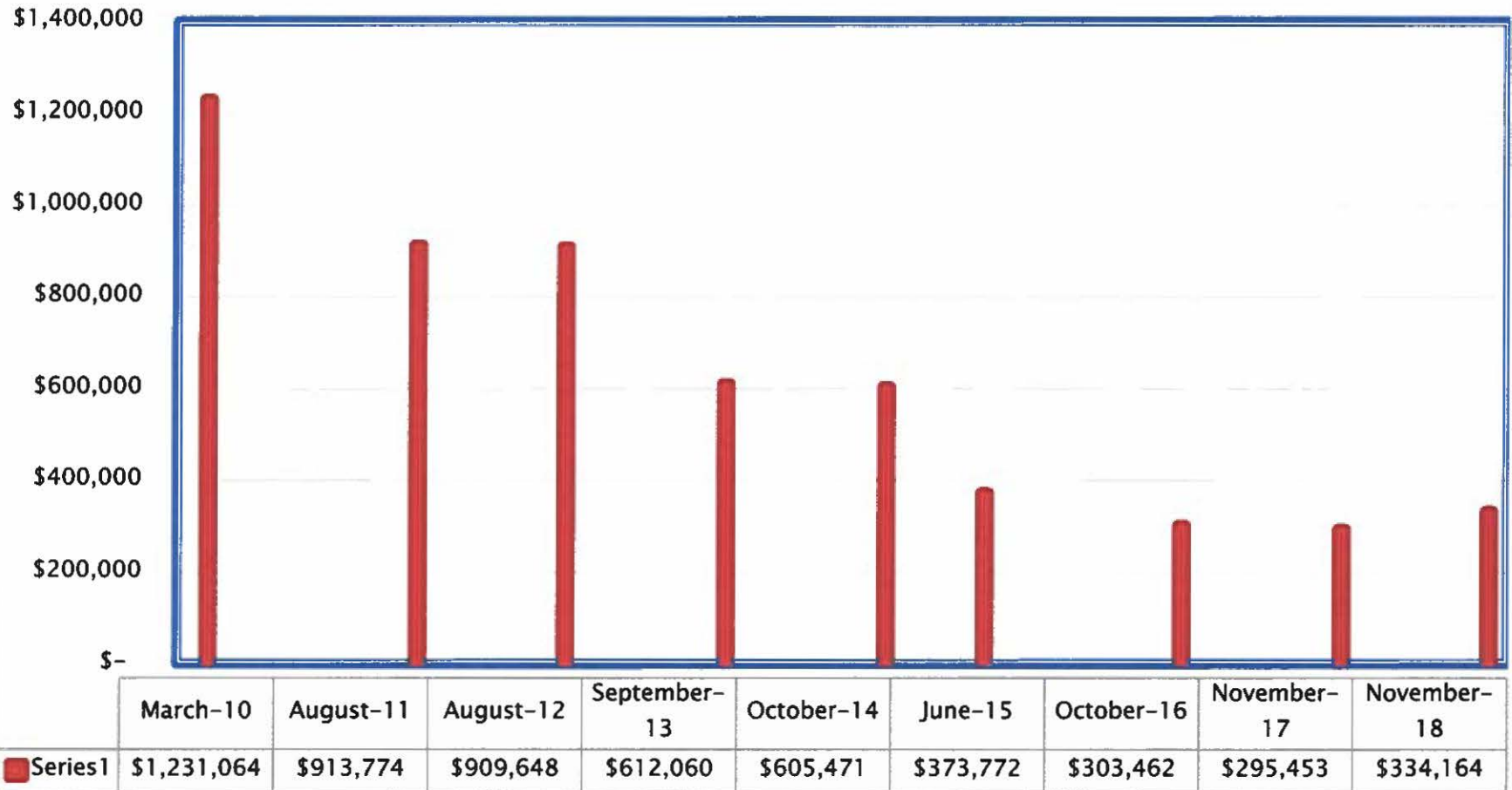

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## EMS Subscription

In the annual Fire & Rescue update that was provided to City Council in November 2017 there was some discussion on ways to increase revenue recovery for the ambulance services we provide but also assist the citizens with options that may ease the burden for the cost of utilizing our ambulance service. Our surrounding neighbors including Southampton County, Isle of Wight County, and the City of Suffolk all offer a subscription service that allows a household to subscribe annually for supplemental coverage that would prevent them from being responsible for any ambulance bill that is above and beyond the limits of their health insurance coverage or if they do not have health insurance.

Southampton County charges an annual rate of \$59.00 with Isle of Wight County and the City of Suffolk charging \$60.00 per household. As we move forward with investigating whether to take a harder line on the recovery of ambulance billing this offer our citizens a fairly inexpensive method of reassurance that they will not face the burden of paying a large sum out of pocket should they need to utilize our ambulance service. I have attached examples of program literature & applications from IOW & the City of Suffolk along with the draft for the City of Franklin.

Franklin Fire & Rescue is recommending that City Council approve & adopt the \$60.00 EMS Subscription program.

City Council approved to start a subscription program for emergency ambulance transportation as part of the City's EMS Revenue Recovery Program. Subscribers insurance, Medicare/Medicaid or any other insurance will be charged for services rendered, then any balance due your subscription would cover it. Subscribers should check with their health insurance carrier to determine if the program is right for them.

For **\$60.00** a year, a subscriber may enroll all members of his or her household. A subscription covers individuals listed on the application form, who reside at the listed address. The EMS Subscription runs from January 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year.


