The Commissioners expressed concern on the "porkchop entrance" that is proposed on the Armory Drive entrance, however, Ms. Walkup, Interim Director of Community Development, and Mr. Jeremy Yee, Professional Engineer of Kimley-Horn, ensured the Commissioners this proposal is the best design for the site. Site plans were approved by the Commissioners. Kimley-Horn submitted Third submittal of site plans on 12/18/2020. As of January 14, site plans are conditionally approved with the contingency of bonds being issued and the plat for combining two parcels has been initiated. The Community Development Division is currently awaiting for building plans and associated land disturbance permit fees. No further progression in February. No further Environmental progression in March. Kimley-Horn continues to work with bond companies to obtain performance surety's for construction activities.</p>
