1.2 SITE WORK

Addendum Note for Clarification: Stump to remain once tree is removed. Stump to be cut to ground level.

1.10 FLOORS (FINISHED)

Hallway

Provide labor, equipment and materials to install transition strips at each doorway that transitions from vinyl to carpet in the hallway. Approx. 4 transition strips needed, contractor to verify quantity needed. Transition strips to be installed per code and product requirements.

1.11 PLUMBING

G Provide labor, equipment, and materials to determine the cause of and repair the leak under the kitchen sink.

1.14 DOORS

- A <u>Addendum Note for Clarification:</u> \$750 per door allowance for labor and materials
- C <u>Addendum Note for Clarification:</u> levered handsets not required, standard round entry knobs can be used to be installed on front, side and shed doors
- D Provide labor, equipment and materials to install exterior pre-hung insulated steel door on shed at rear of home. Foam seal exterior door frame. 3/0x6/8 metal insulated, 6 panel door to be installed. \$750 door allowance for labor and materials.

1.16 INSULATION

- A Provide labor, equipment and materials to install 6-mil. black vapor barrier in crawl space grade after the ground has been raked smooth and all construction debris has been removed, in accordance with local code.
- **B** Provide labor, equipment and materials to install insulation on water supply lines in unheated areas.
- Provide labor, equipment and materials to install R-38 batt or blown insulation in the attic space. Provide and install baffles at eaves according to industry standards. Current code requires R-49 attic insulation. Contractor shall review site conditions with local building code official to determine if R-49 insulation value can be installed in the home or if the R-38 value is sufficient due to site conditions.
- Provide labor, equipment and materials to install R-19 insulation in the crawl space area lacking insulation according to code requirements. Approx. 1100 sf to provide insulation. Contractor to verify actual amount.

Outcome of Items Mentioned at Pre-Bid Not Listed Above:

- 1 There is baseboard heat in this home, the baseboard vents and wall thermostats are to remain. (They are functional.)
- 2 Paneled walls in hallway are to remain untouched.



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- 3 Freeze board at front and back of home to be rehabilitated per the WWU. If a cost saving method can be articulated, changes can be made (via Change Order).
- 4 **CORRECTION:** I indicated that the hall floor and kitchen floor are both several layers thick. The corrected information is the floor in the kitchen is several layers thick the hall flooring is 1-2 layers thick over hardwood flooring.
